The Goldman Sachs MBA Fellowship is an integral part of our diversity recruiting effort. The Fellowship is designed to increase the level of interest in and awareness of careers in the financial services industry among Black, Hispanic and Native American business school students. The Fellowship is also a reflection of our Business Principles and is awarded to recognize outstanding students and the achievements they have made.

Fellowship details

Recipients of the Fellowship will receive:

- A summer internship in a US domestic office. We provide students with the opportunity to work as a summer associate between the first and second years of business school to gain insight into the financial services industry, our firm and our culture
- A \$15,000 award toward tuition, academic and living expenses
- Upon successful completion of the summer internship and acceptance of a full time offer, Goldman Sachs will also underwrite tuition costs associated with the second year of business school or an additional \$15,000 award toward tuition, academic and living expenses

Application process

To be considered for the Goldman Sachs MBA Fellowship, you must complete a "Summer Associate" application online at gs.com/careers with job code **MBAFellow09**. This job code should be entered in the "Positions preference" section of the online application.

Supplemental materials

Please write an essay (500 words maximum) in response to each of the following topics. You must upload your essay as part of your online application.

1. Explain your interest in pursuing a career in the financial services industry. What function (i.e., sales & trading, investment research, investment banking, investment management, finance, operations) interests you most and why?
2. Community involvement and commitment is very important at Goldman Sachs. Please describe your recent involvement with a community-based organization.
